Ability to prepare and deliver bridge simulation courses would be advantageous.

The successful candidates will hold the minimum of a current MCA Certificate of Competency at Officer of the Watch Unlimited (STCW 95 REG 11/1) or Class 1 Deck Officer (Fishing) Level, or equivalent. An MCA Certificate of Competency at Chief Mate Unlimited (STCW 95 REG 11/2) or Master level, or equivalent, would be advantageous. The ideal candidate will also have sailed on a range of vessels, preferably as Master.

The successful candidate will hold current short-course certification (GMDSS, ECDIS,) and be able to clearly explain, both orally and in writing, all aspects of nautical science to students. Good IT skills are also essential.

Good communication and interpersonal skills are also key aspects of the role, together with the ability to build and maintain effective relationships with students and colleagues.
